Power Cell assigned MIDAS to conduct a "Baseline Survey for Global Multi-tier Measurement for Access to energy" (digitally) for Rural Electrification and Renewable Energy Development II (RERED II) Project funded by World Bank. This baseline survey would be carried out for the first time in Bangladesh on access to electricity and improved cooking using the Global Tracking Framework (GTF). 6 sets of elaborate survey tools provided by World Bank will be used for collecting data through Tabs from the field. These tools were used in other countries of similar Baseline survey initiated by World Bank. However, these survey tools were further fine-tuned and adapted considering Bangladesh perspective through series of discussion in MIDAS Office in Dhaka with the visiting consultant from the World Bank Office in Washington DC, USA.

Detailed briefing, field testing of the questionnaires and commencement of survey will be done soon once the finalized tools are approved by Power Cell and other necessary administrative functions are completed.

Monitoring, Evaluation, Design and Supervision of ASSSRB Project









Agricultural Support for Smallholders in South-Western Region of Bangladesh (ASSSRB) is a Project of Department of Agriculture Extension, (DAE) under Ministry of Agriculture of the Government of Bangladesh. The goal of the project is to improve livelihood of

landless, marginal and small farmers through integrated and sustainable productivity. The project is being implemented by DAE and LGED in 58 Upazillas of 9 Districts of South-Western region-Gopalganj, Madripur, Barisal, Patuakhali, Jhalakathi, Barguna, Bhola, Pirojpur and Bagerhat. MIDAS is rendering consultancy services in the field of Monitoring and Evaluating and Design and Supervision of the project. Involvement of MIDAS with ASSSRB Project commenced in January 2016 and will continue till June 2018.

Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) of Bangladesh Government has been implementing Haor Infrastructure and Livelihood Improvement Project (HILIP) in Sunamgonj, Kishoregonj, Netrokona, Habigonj and Brahmanbaria Districts. The objective of the project is to improve living standards and reduce vulnerability of the poor of the project areas.

As per understanding with the HILIP Project, during January- March 2017 quarter, MIDAS conducted two separate training courses of 10-day and 7-day durations titled "Advance Improved Training on Jute Products" and "Advance Improved Training on Bamboo Products" respectively in Habigonj. A total of 40 participants attended these courses, funded by International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and Spanish Trust Fund (STF).
